

## Cookies Policy

---

### 1. CONSENT

By using our website [www.fairs-business.com](http://www.fairs-business.com) you consent to the use of cookies in accordance with this policy. You will have seen a pop up to this effect on your first visit to this website; although it will not usually appear on subsequent visits you may withdraw your consent at any time by following the instructions below.

### 2. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating web domain on your subsequent visits to that domain. Most web pages contain elements from multiple web domains so when you visit [www.fairs-business.com](http://www.fairs-business.com) your browser may receive cookies from several sources.

Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize a user's device. Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember preferences and generally improve the user experience. They can also be used to tailor advertising to your interests through tracking your browsing across websites.

Session cookies are deleted automatically when you close your browser and persistent cookies remain on your device after the browser is closed (for example to remember your user preferences when you return to the site).

### 3. COOKIES AFFECTED BY REGULATIONS AND EXEMPT COOKIES

In accordance to EU directive, cookies that require informed consent by the user are analytical cookies and advertising and affiliation cookies, except those of a technical nature and those necessary for the operation of the website or the provision of services expressly demanded by the user.

### 4. TYPES OF COOKIES

- a) Depending on the entity that manages them, there are innate Cookies (those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the publisher itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided) and from third parties (the that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the editor, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies).
- b) Depending on the time they remain active, there are session cookies (designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page) and persistent cookies (in which the data is stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed during a period defined by the person in charge of cookies (lasting from a few minutes to several years).
- c) Depending on the purpose for which they manage the information they collect, they can be:
  - **Technical cookies** (necessary for the use of the website and the provisions of the contracted service)
  - **Personalization cookies** (that allows the User to access the service with predefined features, such as language, browser type, regional configuration, etc.)
  - **Analysis cookies** (information collected on the use made on the website)
  - **Advertising cookies** (they collect information about preferences and personal choices of Users)
  - **Affiliate cookies** (allows you to track visits from other websites, with which the website establishes an affiliation contract).

### 5. TYPES OF COOKIES USED BY THIS WEBSITE

We describe the categories of cookies Commercial Register and its contractors use below.

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies:** These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features. Without these cookies, services you have asked for (such as navigating between pages) cannot be provided.
